****Notice to Suppliers:**

The following is a DOD interim change to terms and conditions regarding specialty metals. When supplying material that includes specialty metals in support of a U.S. Government contract, you must comply with the requirements prescribed in DFARS 252.225-7014 entitled Preference for Domestic Specialty Metals, and Alternate I. Via Memorandum dated 6 December 2006. Shay D. Assad, Director, Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy, issued Class Deviation 2006-00004 to implement interim DFARS changes as a result of Section 842 of the John Warner National Defense Act for Fiscal Year 2007. This deviation directs the use of clauses entitled "Preference for Domestic Specialty Metals (JUN 2005) (Deviation) and Alternate 1 (APR 2003) (Deviation)". These clauses are hereby applicable to awards made after 15 November 2006. Guidance is also provided in the memorandum for learning other changes to the law and for processing past non-compliances.
